We are looking at completing the final phase of our road project for Victory Road and Shedden Drive this summer. We will post updates of this project on our website.


We will be replacing some of our mowers this spring with new ones so that our public works can continue to keep our Summer Village groomed and make it an enjoyable place to live.

Lagoon Update

Due to several factors, including the fact the Sandy Beach/Sunrise Beach sewage lagoon is at or near capacity, the Summer Village of Sunrise Beach has entered into a one year agreement with the Town of Onoway to have Sunrise Beach's wastewater effluent hauled to the Onoway sewage lagoon. The disposal of wastewater effluent will be reviewed prior to reaching this one year timeline, and a decision moving forward will be made at that time.
