## BYLAW #26-1990

A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SUNRISE BEACH IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SPEED LIMITS WITHIN THE VILLAGE DESIGNATED IN METRIC UNITS.

Under the authority and pursuant to the provisions of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980, Chapter H-7, Section 14, the Council of the Summer Village of Sunrise Beach enacts as follows:

- (1) That this bylaw may be cited as "The Speed Limit Bylaw"
- (2) No person shall drive or otherwise operate a vehicle of any description however propelled on any street or roadway or private property within the Summer Village of Sunrise Beach at a speed in excess of fifty (50) kilometers per hour except in areas which are posted with a thirty (30) kilometer per hour limit, except that the driver of an ambulance, fire fighting equipment, police vehicle, or Gas Company Emergency vehicle, may, in emergencies, exceed the said speed limits.
- (3) The driver of a vehicle shall drive with due regard for other traffic and shall, whenever necessary for safety reasons, reduce speed below the permitted speed limits.
- (4) A driver shall not drive at a speed in excess of that indicated on any temporary sign which the Council may cause to be erected because of what they considered sufficiently unusual circumstances.
- (5) Any person who operates a vehicle contrary to the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and subject to the penalties provided by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.
