## SUMMER VILLAGE OF SUNRISE BEACH BYLAW NO. 120 -09

## BEING A BYLAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SUNRISE BEACH, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO CONTROL LAND USE.

**WHEREAS** a Council of the Municipality may, pursuant to Section 7 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statues of Alberta 2000, and any amendments thereto, pass bylaws amending the Land Use Bylaw;

**WHEREAS** the Summer Village of Sunrise Beach wishes to amend and clarify the siting requirements for accessory buildings and buildings attached to principal buildings within the Municipality under Land Use Bylaw No. 99-04; and

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the Summer Village of Sunrise Beach, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

The Summer Village of Sunrise Beach Land Use Bylaw No. 99-04 is hereby amended by making the following changes:

1. adding Section 31(I), which shall read as follows:

"Where a building is attached to a principal building, as defined in Section 27, and that building is designed and used primarily for the storage of motor vehicles, the rear yard setback shall be the same as for garages.

AND WHEREAS this Bylaw comes into full force and effect upon third reading.
